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GDA STRATEGY DUE TO CHANGES IN THE PANDEMIC MANAGEMENT AND VACCINATION STRATEGIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF SPAIN |

The purpose of the review of the Action Protocol against exposure to the new coronavirus (SARS-COV-2) of GDA is to determine the position of **GRUPO DANIEL ALONSO** regarding the changes in the “STRATEGY FOR EARLY DETECTION, SURVEILLANCE AND CONTROL OF COVID- 19 ”of the Government of Spain and the evolution of the VACCINATION STRATEGY

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COVID-19 EARLY DETECTION, SURVEILLANCE AND CONTROL STRATEGY | JUNE 23, 2021 UPDATE

According to this document, issued by the Ministry of Health and the Carlos III Health Institute, people who have received a complete vaccination schedule and are considered as close contact will be **exempt from quarantine**. Se les hará una **PCR al inicio y otra a los 7 días del último contacto** con el caso confirmado y se recomendará evitar el contacto con personas vulnerables y con personas no vacunadas.

A **PCR** will be done **at the beginning** and **another one 7 days after** the last contact with the confirmed case and it will be recommended to avoid contact with vulnerable and unvaccinated people.

Likewise, they will be instructed to use a mask in their social interactions, not to attend mass events and to monitor the possible appearance of symptoms; if these appear, follow the indications of the GP.

This means that **they will not cause sick leave and will be able to continue working throughout that period**.

The **same criteria** will be followed for asymptomatic people who have passed COVID-19 in the previous 180 days and are close contacts.

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VACCINATION CERTIFICATES | Immunity considerations

To be considered a **fully vaccinated person**, it should have received 2 doses of vaccine spaced at least:

- 19 days if the first dose was of the Pfizer vaccine
- 21 days for AstraZeneca
- 25 days in the case of Moderna

and that a minimum period has elapsed since the last dose of:

- 7 days if the last dose was Pfizer
- 14 days if it was AstraZeneca or Moderna

They are also considered fully vaccinated persons who have received one dose of vaccine Janssen more than 14 days ago.

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SUBCONTRACTORS AND VISITS | Immunity considerations

Taking into account the above considerations to be considered a **fully vaccinated person**, external companies or hired workers, in order to provide services in any of the facilities of **GRUPO DANIEL ALONSO**, must submit for each worker:

❖ NEGATIVE result Report of a test for the detection of anti SARS-CoV-2.

or

❖ Certificate of vaccination against COVID-19, bearing in mind that must have passed since the last dose:

- 1 week after the second dose of a 2-dose series of Pfizer vaccine

or

- 2 weeks week after the second dose of a 2-dose series of AstraZeneca or Moderna vaccines

or

- 2 weeks after receiving a single-dose Johnson & Johnson Janssen vaccine

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USE OF MASK

Although since 06/26/2021 the use of masks is no longer mandatory in public outdoor spaces, while the safety distance of 1.5 meter must be maintained and the mask always must be carried, **in all GDA facilities** as long as there is no more generalized immunity, **the obligation of generalized use of the mask will be maintained**, as contemplated in the current *Protocol of action against exposure to the new coronavirus (SARS-COV-2)* and as it has been doing until now.

Before this announcement, **GDA** has decided to be cautious with this flexibility in all its facilities since the contagions continue throughout the territory and that there is still a risk for people who do not have the full vaccination schedule with its deadlines after the second dose and, of course, those who do not have any.

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PLEASE, REMEMBER: |

USE A MASK. Use it whenever you are with people even if the safety distance is respected between people. Avoid as much as possible touching the mask in the center and / or placing it anywhere.

WASH YOUR HANDS. Wash them frequently with soap and water, whenever you are in contact with objects or people external of you and before touching your face, eating or handling food.

VENTILATE THE PLACES. Pay special attention to the ventilation and renewal of the air in your home or workplace, make sure that it is a cross ventilation, that the new air enters through a window and on the opposite side the air to renew can come out.

TRY TO REDUCE YOUR SOCIAL ACTIVITY. The Principality of Asturias recommends not to hang out with more than 6 people, the contagion is mainly from person to person, so it is important to be prudent at this moment. In the working aspect, try to minimize as much as possible to keep contact with colleagues during breaks, in the lockers, entrances or exits to the workshop, etc. Likewise, avoid holding face-to-face meetings and opt for virtual channels whenever possible.

SI PRESENTAS SÍNTOMAS ANTES DE TU JORNADA, CONTACTA CON LA EMPRESA. En caso de fiebre, tos, insuficiencia respiratoria, falta de olfato, etc, contacta con tu responsable en la empresa y **NO ACUDAS** hasta que no hayas contactado con él. Asimismo, comunica tu situación a tu médico de cabecera para que te indique como proceder. **IF YOU HAVE ANY SYMPTOMS BEFORE WORK, CONTACT WITH THE COMPANY.** In case of fever, cough, respiratory failure, lack of smell, etc., contact your manager at the company and **DO NOT COME** until you have contacted. Also, communicate your situation to your GP to show you how to proceed.

NOTICE IN CASE OF TRAVEL. If you are going to travel outside Asturias, please notify HR or HSE to make an appointment for a coronavirus test **before joining**.

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
